Principal Sir greeted everyone and explained the agenda of the meeting to help the students academically.

Formation of PTA- Sir explained the importance of the PTA Body to help in the progress of the school, development of the students in the conducive environment. The purpose of the 1st meeting to be held offline as the PTA Executive Body need to be formed.

PTA Members introduced themselves to all the teachers & parents present for the meeting.

Principal Sir complemented all the parents & teachers to support the students in their development and also taking care of the task such as safety of the child, Mental health of the child & academic goal should not take a back seat.

Last year to help the students digitally, teachers started equipping themselves with the digital mode and parents equipped themselves digitally as well as for their basic needs.

Sir also explained that we are not focussing on marks but learning of the students, knowledge of the students which will continue and with this objective we achieved 100% result in Board exams in Grade X & XII (2020-21). Sir also detailed the toppers and subject toppers of the school of Grade X. Grade XII was the 1st batch in 2020-21 & with challenges & opportunities, students came out with flying colours with 92% in Science stream, 89% in Commerce stream & 89.2% in Allied stream.

Sir detailed about the Co-scholastic aspect of the students through various activities & competitions participated by the student. Eg:

- Sun dial activity conducted in 2020-21 which was recorded in Guinness World Book Record wherein 54 students participated & recorded their names.
- Socio chat platform started by 2 students of Grade 10 & recorded in Made in India entrepreneur
- Students participated in Toy Fair wherein teaching aids were created by students. 10 projects from our school were appreciated. 25 schools participated at National level.
- Fitness – DMWA achieved 5 Rating scale in FIT INDIA by the government.

Assessment process:-

CBSE has suggested Assessment pattern as Term I & II for the academic year 2021-22 in Grade X & XII. The syllabus is rationalised to 25% i.e. learning through activities, projects, quizzes etc.

Same process will be continued with Grade 1 to 8 also. Art Integration activity with other subjects- to involve students & creating or competency is developed among students. Assessment pattern to be followed is

- ➔ Multiple choice questions i.e. direct and case study questions.
- ➔ Term 2 – Objective & subjective questions (in case situation is normal)

For writing practice, Periodic Test & Class Assignment will be given and Term I will be MCQ's as the focus is on enhancement of learning & writing will be taken care during physical form of school.

Sir also explained concerns of the teachers with the parents:-

- Students not switching on the cameras during the online class.
- Health concern of the students – exercise are taught but not implemented / executed resulted in obesity of the students.
- Notes of the subjects made by the students.

Parent's concern:-

- Break time to increase
- Extramarks
- 15% fees reduction

Sir replied to the above concerns

- 1) Break time will be 20 mins for the students.
- 2) Extramarks – Last year along with extramarks content already with other platforms were used. This year extramarks – assessment, worksheet, attendance etc. are incorporated with the students and teachers. However, there are few technical glitches related to the bandwidth as a result the technical team is working on the same.
- 3) Fees reduction – Only there is an announcement and no GR has received in such concern whereas the fees reduction was announced for 2020-21 & related to Rajasthan schools.
Our school has already given fees reduction in 2020-21 and as soon as it is received from the government, the decision will be communicated to the parents. Sir also explained that maintenance & other expenses are continued of the school.
Sir also detailed regarding the extension of the fees payment, monthly payments facility etc. as per the request made by the parents.
- 4) Assignment during examinations – these examinations are formative in nature and assignments are to enhance the learning & revision of the topic.
- 5) 1st instalment cheque to be collected on 1st April instead of 5th March due to IT related for the financial year. However, sir explained that clearance of 1st cheque is the assurity of the child continuation in the school and case to case parent concern is honoured for the same.
- 6) Communication between parents, teachers & management can be through what's app group, mails etc. It is responded as early as possible in case immediate response is required and related to academics or administration related tasks.
