School is the centre for Board Examination and the dates for summer break and re-opening date for the month of June will be announced after receiving complete information from the Board.

• School Timings:

Sr. Secondary & Secondary Section: Grade VI to XII : 7.30~am to 12.50~pm , reporting time- 7.20~am

Primary Section: Grade I to V: $1.10 \ pm$ to $5.30 \ pm$, reporting time- 1.00 pm

• <u>Uniform:</u> Pupil shall come to school in complete and proper uniform, including all such instances where students are representing school outside.

Due to large scale transition in Post Pandemic especially after school re-opening announcement, the new set of uniform shall be available by April end. Therefore pupil shall be allowed to come in white shirt/T-shirt and black pants till the new uniforms are made available. This arrangement is made for this academic session only.

• **<u>Hair:</u>** Boys shall have simple and short haircut.

Fancy haircut/fancy hairstyle is strictly prohibited.

Girls with long hair must plait their hair.

White hair band is a part of uniform and it must be worn by all girls in school campus, inside bus and outside school campus while representing school.

Coloured rubber bands and fancy hair clips are prohibited.

Colouring, bleaching or styling of hair is prohibited.

- Nails: Nails should be cut regularly. Nail enamel is not permitted.
- **Shoes:** Black sports shoes with Velcro should be worn with uniform.

During rainy season: Pupil shall wear black crocs/all season black sports shoes. Sandals or sleepers are strictly prohibited.

- <u>Accessories:</u> Fancy articles such as chains, bracelets, watches, earrings are at parents' risk. School is not responsible for any loss.
- Appearance: Students are expected to look pleasant, orderly and presentable.
- <u>Identity card</u>: Students shall come in temporary Id Card with details of Walking/Private Van/Bus details.

Students should take bath before coming to school, they must wash their hands before and after eating.
