2. Vocabulary usually evolves as our reading grows and serves as a fundamental tool for communication. Let us acquire new words.

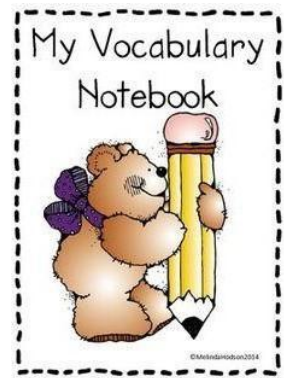
😊 **Children will have to make their own dictionary.**

Instructions for creating dictionary

Things you'll need:

- Scrapbook or homemade booklet
- Pencil colours, crayons, markers etc.
- Scissors
- Glue



1. Take a scrap book to make your dictionary. Try to get paper that will hold up to drawing, pictures and pasting.
 2. Decide whether you want to draw or paste pictures.
 3. Choose words that are commonly used and that will be easy to draw or find pictures to represent.
 4. Begin drawing or cutting out pictures that correspond to the words you have chosen. One page can be used for one letter and its corresponding words and their pictures.
 5. Help the children find suitable pictures. Allow children to draw and the one, who are not confident in their art skills, can find and cut out pictures from magazines.
 6. Do not forget to write the meaning of the words chosen so that it can benefit the other students too in building their vocabulary.

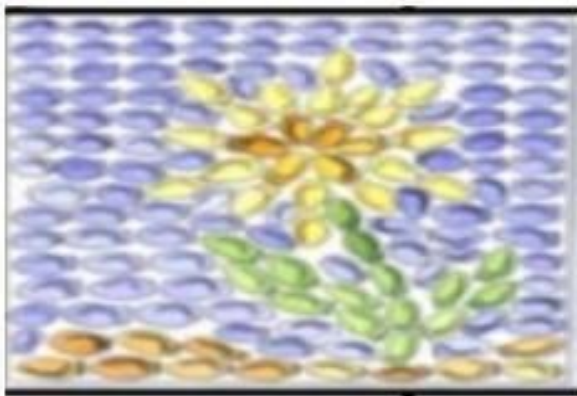
EVS ACTIVITY 3
