- School re-opening details:

Grade	Details
X & XII	School re-opens on 05.06.2023. Attendance on the re-opening day is mandatory.
I to IX	School re-opens on 12.06.2023. Attendance on the re-opening day is mandatory.

### <u>Timetable:</u>

- School Bags must be arranged as per the time table for the day and packed daily.
- Parents must check their wards' bag every day and adhere to the timetable, the book schedule and copy checking schedule (for classes 3 to 8).
- Students are not allowed to carry any sort of magazine, pen drive, CD, DVD or any other item which is not required in their teaching learning process.
- Sharp objects like knife, blade, and cutters must not be carried to school in any case.
- Uniform: Pupil shall come to school in complete and proper Sports uniform only. New admission students or students not having sports uniform shall be allowed in casual descent wear for 1 week only.

Pupil shall wear School uniform on the prescribed day only.

- School sports uniform (house colour uniform will be worn by the students on all days except Friday). Every Friday students need to wear school uniform only.
- ▶ <u>Hair:</u> Boys shall have simple and short haircut.

Fancy haircut/fancy hairstyle is strictly prohibited.

Girls with long hair must plait their hair.

White hair band is a part of uniform and it must be worn by all girls in school campus, inside bus and outside school campus while representing school.

Coloured rubber bands and fancy hair clips are prohibited.

Colouring, bleaching or styling of hair is prohibited.

- > <u>Nails:</u> Nails should be trimmed regularly. Nail enamel is not permitted.
- Shoes: Black sports shoes with Velcro should be worn with uniform.

**During rainy season**: Pupil shall wear black crocs/all season black sports shoes. Sandals or sleepers are strictly prohibited. Black crocs shall not be allowed after October1, 2023

Accessories: Fancy articles such as chains, bracelets, watches, earrings are at parents' risk. School is not responsible for any loss.

> <u>Appearance</u>: Students are expected to look pleasant, orderly and presentable.

## Admit Cards:

- Students shall carry the Admit cards provided to them daily from the re-opening day as it shall be checked at the school gate for entry.
- Children failed to produce Admission cards shall be sent back under intimation to parents.
- Mobile Phones shall not be allowed until specified. In case mobile phones are

found in possession of child the same shall be confiscated & handed over to parent on the PTM day with a request note.

Farewell is scheduled on 21st April, 2023 for students of Grade X & XII(2022-23) batch.

- Grade X & XII (2023-24) students timing shall be 12.50pm to 6.30 pm. Bus facility shall be available for bus students only.
- Grade VI to IX (2023-24) shall have regular school.
- Grade I to V (2023-24) students shall have half day, timing: 12.50 pm to 3.30 pm. Bus facility shall be available for bus students.
