General instructions for students:

3. Selected recipe of the region assigned should be prepared at home and presented in the school.
4. Selected students for food stall need to bring hand gloves, serving vessels, tissue papers, cooking apron and chef cap compulsorily.
5. There will be a coupon system for purchasing food and participating in game on the stalls. Per coupon charges is **Rs.20**. According to the requirement students can bring the money.
