Rules & Regulations: ● Participant must put up his / her points in given timeframe i.e. 3 minutes ● All the participants will be divided into two groups/ teams (Affirmation Team & Negation Team) ● Sequences of the students will be decided using a draw system / Alphabetical order of the names of the students. ● One student from the Affirmation team will start the debate and then the negation team and the sequence would be followed by the rest of the participants. ● Participants will not get a second chance to speak. No rebuttal round ● No cross questioning / arguments by the fellow participants ● The speech content must be self-made or idea based (no plagiarism, no cut copy paste from the Internet) ● As soon as the speaker concludes his/ her constructive speech they will be questioned by the judges. ● Students will be given a placard of 'I AGREE' symbol, students may use the placard while the contestant is giving the answer to the question of the judges.

We humbly remind you to take the note of the following:

- Notebooks and textbooks should be covered with transparent sheets and properly labelled.
- <u>Hair:</u> Boys shall have simple and short haircut. Girls with long hair must plait their hair. White hair band is a part of uniform and it must be worn by all girls in school campus, inside bus and outside school campus while representing school.
 - Coloured rubber bands and fancy hair clips are prohibited. Colouring, bleaching or styling of hair is prohibited.
- **Nails:** Nails should be trimmed regularly. Nail enamel is not permitted.
- **Shoes:** Black sports shoes with Velcro should be worn with uniform.
 - **During rainy season**: Pupil shall wear black crocs/all season black sports shoes. Sandals or sleepers are strictly prohibited. <u>Black crocs shall be allowed from June to September and strictly prohibited from 1st October(once the rain stop).</u>
- Winter wear: Students shall wear Grey color sweatshirt during cold weather only.
- **Appearance:** Students are expected to look pleasant, orderly and presentable.
- Identity card: Students shall come in temporary Id Card with details of Walking/Private Van/Bus details along with contact number and residential address mentioned clearly.
- Admit cards:

- These cards shall be checked daily from June,2025 onwards at the school gate for entry. Therefore children must carry these cards on daily basis.
- Children failed to produce Admission cards shall be sent back under intimation to parents.
- ➤ <u>Mobile Phones</u> is strictly prohibited in primary classes. Grade 9 onwards shall not be allowed until specified. In case mobile phones are found in possession of child the same shall be confiscated & handed over to parent on the PTM day after the receipt of duly signed application from parents.
